#### CURRICULUM OUTLINE

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#### Session One: Winning with Competition

Students play a pricing game to learn about the nation's market economy, consisting of consumers and producers, and how price, variety, and quality are affected by competition.

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#### Session Two: Innovation Nation

Students explore how they can improve products or processes to benefit both people and the environment. They engage in problem-solving and innovation to enhance sustainability.

#### Session Three: Success Skills

Students play a board game to understand and explore transferable skills and apply those skills to life and work situations. Thinking about the essential question "What skills will help me be successful in my job or career?" helps them to evaluate their own transferable skills.

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#### Session Four: Career Horizons

Students explore how their interests and skills can guide them in considering various jobs and careers in the nation. They will contemplate different occupations and reflect on how their unique strengths and passions influence the type of work they might want to pursue.

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#### Session Five: Connecting for a Cause

Students are introduced to philanthropy and the importance of helping others in the community. They brainstorm the resources needed to plan small group projects aimed at creating a community center. Each group evaluates the resources they have and what they still need. Then, they network with one another to locate, negotiate, and trade for the time, treasure, and talent resources required to complete their projects.
